Pre-Sprint Work Session:

Week 1: Understanding, Discovery and Ideation

One 2-hour Strategy Session

Goals: Kickoff meeting with all stakeholders to outline the sprint's goals, expectations, and schedule.

Define the specific AI integration challenges and opportunities. Our end outcome is to have two channels to target where we can take a deeper AI dive along with action items.

Homework – The startup stakeholders will be given research homework related to the action items and communication channels will be established for the startup to get practical feedback from experienced AI engineers.

Week 2: Ideation Workshop

One 2-hour Strategy Session

Goals: We will map out user journeys to identify where AI can enhance the user experiences, improve efficiency or create new value. We'll then develop a working concept and develop action items.

Homework – The startup will be asked to develop core features for the AI concept that we collectively decided on.

Week 3: Al Roadmap

One 2-hour Strategy Session

Goals: We will outline the scope, core features, required technologies, potential challenges and expected outcomes for the AI concept that we decided on.
